Barrier for Dreamers

Exclusion from occupational and professional licenses and certifications

"I finished my degree... The only obstacle ...was actually getting a License....

Even though I have the education and I excelled"

LICENSING AND CERTIFICATION A STATE FUNCTION

CRITERIA DIFFERS STATE TO STATE

NON-CITIZENS AND CITIZENS MUST MEET QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

LEGISLATURE and AGENCIES SET REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW YORK LICENSES AND CERTIFICATIONS

- EDUCATION
- EXPERIENCE
- RELEVANT EXAMINATIONS

MAY DIFFER FROM OTHER STATES

BOTTOM LINE ON IMMIGRANT STATUS REQUIREMENTS

- *If no state legislative restrictions –
- None should be applied
- * Legislative or Regulatory **restrictions can violate** STATE and federal **constitutions**.
 - **13 restrictive NY statutes declared unconstitutional by SECOND CIRCUIT
- *Members of the **executive** and **legislative** and judicial branches of state government have the **obligation** to assure compliance with the State and federal constitutions.

NEW YORK STATE

OVER 130 OCCUPATIONS LICENSED OR CERTIFIED BY NEW YORK STATE

- REGULATED BY STATE ADMINISTRATIVE DEPARTMENTS
 - **E.G.** MOST OCCUPATIONS REGULATED BY THE **NY DEPARTMENT OF STATE** DO NOT HAVE LEGISLATION

 THAT RESTRICTS BASED ON IMMIGRANT STATUS

 AND
 - THE NEW YORK DEPARTMENT OF STATE DOES NOT IMPOSE RESTRICTIONS ON THOSE OCCUPATIONS
 - ADDITIONALLY LOCALITIES REGULATE SOME

AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATIONS OF THE NYS COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION FOR PROFESSIONAL LICENSING AND TEACHER CERTIFICATION JUNE 2016

"No **otherwise qualified alien** shall be precluded from obtaining a professional license...

if an individual is **not unlawfully present** in the United States,

including but not limited to individuals granted Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals....

(INCLUDES PRUCOLS)

PRUCOL – PERMANENTLY RESIDING UNDER COLOR OF LAW

Noncitizen residing in US with knowledge and permission or acquiescence of USCIS/ICE

- Deferred Action under DACA
- Deferred Action
- *Request for Deferred Action pending 6+ months, not denied
- *Applicants for any immigration benefit
 - E.g. Applicants for Special Immigrant Juvenile Status
- Asylum/Withholding under INA or CAT
- Cancellation of Removal
- Temporary Protected Status (TPS)
- Temporary Protected Status (TPS)
- In valid Nonimmigrant Status
 - E.g. T U visas (*F B H for licensing NOT UNLAWFULLY PRESENT)
- Immediate Relatives with approved I-130

PRUCOL – Others

- Approved Petition on and Pending Application for Green Card
- Granted withholding of removal under CAT (Convention Against Torture)
- O Paroled for less than 1 year
- Order of supervision

CALIFORNIA



No entity.... shall deny licensure to an applicant based on his or her citizenship status or immigration status.

Court authorized to admit as an attorney at law "an applicant who is <u>not</u> lawfully present in the United States [who] has fulfilled the requirements for admission to practice law...."

"The Legislature finds and declares that it is in the best interests of the State of California to provide persons who are not lawfully present in the United States with the state benefits provided by all licensing acts of entities within the department..."

FINANCING EDUCATION NY TAP

An applicant (a) must be a **citizen** of the United States, or (b) must be an alien lawfully admitted for **permanent residence** in the United States, or (c) must be an individual of a **class of refugees paroled** by the attorney general of the United States under his parole authority

Education law 661 (3)

ANTIQUATED –DOES NOT REFLECT CURRENT IMMIGRATION LAW
